SCORM presentation: SCORM – Today and Tomorrow

- Sharable Content Object Reference Model - A collection of standards and specification for web-based e-learning.
- Initiated 1997 in U.S. Defense Department (ADL) to eliminate redundancy in DoD online training
- RAID: reusable, accessible, interoperable, durable
- Most recent edition released in 2006; includes sequencing metadata
- LMSs support different versions of SCORM (Vista 4 supports 2.1) creating compatibility problems
- SCORM support tools are available but not easy to use
- Intellectual property rights of sharable content is a big issue
- SCORM has not yet addressed issues of Web 2.0 (Second Life, wikis, MMORPG, etc.)
- Instructor-level tools for developing SCORM conformant/compliant content are not yet available
- DoD and some industry grants require SCORM compliance; so knowledge of and ability to use SCORM is of value
