### **Discussion of Elluminate Support:**

- Elluminate company support is weak
- Doug will broker a meeting of Elluminate users
- Adding a cost-per-student to pay for central support could be implemented, but programs would have to pay for this. Because this is not a materials fee it cannot be passed down to students according to UF policies. [proposal for Help Desk-level support + LSS "go-to person"]
- Pharmacy: perceived need for central coordination of communication with vendor; e.g. attendance-taking feature
- Elluminate support recently gave wrong support information based on confusion about what kind of hosted instance is provided for UF.
- Proposal: UF-Elluminati become user group similar to VIP group with central coordination.
- Doug Johnson will broker a meeting of Elluminate users to discuss support issues and prepare a proposal for Fedro.
  - Establish a wiki site for shared support materials?

- Recommendations to date
  - Mobile support for online tools (e.g. the CMS)- report provided to CSM Review Committee for consideration in evaluation
  - Campus-wide visual roster for courses: report given to ITAC-AT; preparing pilot for this program
  - Review of e-Portfolio systems: Data reported to CMS committee for consideration
  - Technology adoption strategy and plan: Program now being tested in HSC
- Now reviewing new Educause Horizons Report for next set of future directions
  - Interests: Game design and construction tools, virtual worlds, Web 2.0 pedagogy, continuing study of mobile devices broadening to use beyond CMS, video tagging tools, personal learning environments (broader learning networks beyond class-specific use), non-credit short course delivery system.

### **Discussion of Remote Proctoring**

- College of Business has tested Remote Proctor and found it unsatisfactory
  - camera and microphone are inadequate to capture/document cheating with high enough quality to accuse the student
- Is now looking to evaluate WebAssesor <https://www.webassessor.com>
  - This is an assessment proctoring service

### **Voice Thread Demo – Jennifer Smith**

- collaborative, asynchronous, multimedia slide show that holds images, documents, and videos and allows people to leave comments in multiple ways using voice (with a mic or phone), text, audio file, or video (via a webcam).
- Content stored at VoiceThread service but can be exported to mp3 players (as a point-in-time snapshot of the project)
